The applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, an undergraduate currently enrolled in an accredited academic program (part-time or full-time), and not scheduled to graduate earlier than December 2010. If accepted into this program, all field trip expenses will be paid, lodging will be provided in Kansas City, and you will receive a summer stipend of \$4,500. You are responsible for your meals while in Kansas City, for tuition (at a reduced rate), and for the cost of travel to and from Kansas City (if you live outside the continental United States, you may be eligible for an additional travel stipend of up to \$800).

You must be available for orientation in Kansas City beginning 24 May 2010, participate in the field trip to the Grenadines in June, and commit to a full summer of research and manuscript preparation (results of past student projects have been submitted successfully for publication). The program will terminate on 30 July. You may enroll in up to 6 hours of credit in Biology Research from Avila University. All applicants will be notified of their status no later than 22 February and accepted applicants must respond by 29 February to hold their position in the program (the early response date is necessary to give participants who do not have a passport time to apply and receive one prior to departure in June and to finalize travel arrangements).
