



- E A minimum of 64 semester hours must be completed at a four-year institution. The final thirty (30) hours must be completed at Avila University. A minimum GPA of 2.0 (C) is required for graduation in all work attempted, including transfer credits. At least 12 upper-division hours in the major must be completed at Avila. All upper-division courses in the major must have a minimum grade of C. All courses specifically required for the major must be completed with a grade of C or higher.
- E Credit/No Credit Policy: No major courses specifically required for the major may be taken CR/NC. No more than 12 hours of the CR/NC grade option are applied toward an Avila Degree. See Avila catalog for policy.
- E Only one repeat of a required business or economics course by a business major will be permitted.
