



A minimum of 64 semester hours must be completed at a four-year institution. The final thirty (30) hours must be completed at Avila University. A minimum GPA of 2.0 (C) is required for graduation in all work attempted, including transfer credits. At least 12 upper-division hours in the major must be completed at Avila.

All upper-division courses in the major must have a minimum grade of C. A minimum grade of C is required in all major courses.
