

Management

Students who major in Management are well-positioned for various roles in many different industries and sectors (e.g., government, education, private industry). Responsibilities may involve planning, directing, and coordinating the activities of an organization. A manager often oversees the work of others by building cooperation and performance among team members. Students majoring in Management may train or specialize in a number of functional areas including accounting, marketing, finance, or human resources. The skills needed to be successful may include analyzing problems, decision making, delegating assignments, training and supervising staff, budgeting, and coordinating activities.

Management trainee positions are typically available in the retail, hotel/restaurant, banking, and insurance industries. Management trainee programs may last six to twelve months and provide exposure to the various functional areas within the organization. Many people enter management positions with a bachelor's degree. However, a Master's degree in Business Administration (MBA) is essential in some areas for advancement.
