

Nursing

Nursing is a broad occupation area which accommodates many opportunities for specialization such as surgery, maternity, pediatrics, emergency room, intensive care, or involvement in specific health areas such as the heart or cancer. Some nurses work in home health agencies, schools, public health, and occupational settings with other opportunities also available for nurses who want administrative or nursing education roles.
