Student Eligibility Requirements

To receive a TEACH Grant, you must...

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- Be enrolled in coursework that is necessary to begin a career in teaching.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 throughout your academic program.

Teaching Obligation

To avoid repaying the TEACH Grant as a loan with interest, you must be a highly-qualified, full-time teacher in a high-need subject area at a school serving low-income families.
