I. Foundations (9-11 credit hours)

a. All courses must be passed with a grade of “C” or higher.

II. Pillars and Levels (30 credit hours)

The chart below is cross-listed demonstrating how taking a course meets both a pillar & level requirement at Avila.

- Each pillar must have 6 credit hours of coursework.
- Acquire & Transform levels combined must have 24 credit hours of coursework, which includes the 6 hours from each pillar.
- The Contribute level must have 6 credit hours of coursework. Most courses in this level will be completed at Avila University.
- All courses must have a passing grade.

- I. **Core Designations: Most courses in this category will be completed at Avila University. (NOTE: These courses may count for core and/or major/minor credit as well as designation credit)**
- a. **If transferring less than 30 credits:**
 - i. 9 credit hours of Interdisciplinary Studies (IS) courses
 - ii. 9 credit hours of Global Studies (GS) courses
 - iii. 3 credit hours of Community Engagement (CE) courses
 - b. **Transferring 30-59 credits:**
 - i. 6 credit hours of Interdisciplinary Studies (IS) courses
 - ii. 6 credit hours of Global Studies (GS) courses
 - iii. 3 credit hours of Community Engagement (CE) courses
 - c. **Transferring 60 or more credits:**
 - i. 3 credit hours of Interdisciplinary Studies (IS) courses
 - ii. 3 credit hours of Global Studies (GS) courses
 - iii. 3 credit hours of Community Engagement (CE) courses
 - iv. 3 additional credit hours from choice of Interdisciplinary Studies, Global Studies or Community Engagement courses
 - d. **Transferring in Associate of Arts (AA) or equivalent:**
Transfer students coming to Avila with an Associate of Arts or equivalent academic degree will be considered to have completed **all Foundation and Pillar & Level requirements (39 hours)**. They are still required to complete the designations as listed under transfer students with 60 or more credits listed in (III c).
 - e. **Transferring in Bachelor's degree or higher:**
Transfer students coming to Avila with a Bachelor's degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution will be considered to have the equivalent of an Associate of Arts degree for the purpose of the core curriculum.
