One way that we monitor our impact in our local PK-12 community, is through an annual placement report provided by the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE). This report includes our program reporters since 2010 that are currently working in Missouri public education. The data provided below is a summary from our 2021 placement report.
