

HONORS PROGRAM QUICK FACTS



PERKS

- \$1000/year Honors Grant tuition discount
- No additional credit hours required – all experiences count toward graduation once the program is completed
- Cords at graduation
- Honors designation on diploma

REQUIREMENTS: What do you have to do?

Each requirement is roughly equal to 1 credit hour of work



SEMINARS (2)

HN 180 (1 credit hour):
Take this your first Fall in the program.

HN 480 (1 credit hour):
Take this your last Fall in the program.



HONORS ENHANCEMENTS (5)

You get to decide which classes are Honors classes! Ask the faculty teaching one of your courses (any course) if you can do an Honors Enhancement. You decide on the specifics of the experience with the instructor. You do five HEs, spread out over any semesters you want.



CULTURE & COMMUNITY (2)

Choose 2 semesters (including Summer!) to attend 4 events in the community (we give you a list of events)

You will earn 1 credit hour for each of these once you have completed all program requirements.

APPLY TO THE HONORS PROGRAM:

Students are accepted on a rolling basis and waitlisted once the program is full.

First-year students with a 3.50+ HS GPA or 25+ ACT or 1200+ SAT are pre-admitted and need to formally accept a place in the program or waitlist.

First-year students with a 3.25+ HS GPA are conditionally admitted and will need to submit an admissions essay or academic letter of recommendation.

Current or transfer students must have two of the following: 3.50+ college GPA, academic letter of recommendation, and admissions essay (<1500 words)
