REQUIREMENTS: What do Honors students do?

HN 480 (1 credit hour): Take this your last year in the program.



HONORS ENHANCEMENTS (HEs): 5

You get to decide which classes are Honors classes! Ask the faculty teaching any of your courses if you can do an Honors Enhancement. You decide on the specifics of the experience together. Your five HEs can be spread out over any semesters you want (including Summer).

Credit hours for HEs are free.

APPLY TO THE HONORS PROGRAM:

Students are accepted on a rolling basis and waitlisted once the program is full. **First-year students** with a 3.50+ HS GPA or 25+ ACT or 1200+ SAT score of 1200+ are preadmitted and need to formally accept their admission to the Honors Program.

First-year students with a 3.25-3.49 HS GPA are conditionally admitted and are required to submit an admission essay.

Current or transfer students must have two of the following: 3.50+ College GPA, academic letter of recommendation, and admission essay (<1500 words).
