FERPA is a federal law that protects a student’s privacy and prevents sharing information to a third party unless the student gives permission.

Log in to your MyAU

- Click on the ‘Academics’ tab
- Click ‘Set FERPA Permissions’ on the left
- Click ‘Define New Permission’
- Follow the prompts to complete the process
- It may take several days before the permission is entered in the AU system
