

Instructions for Submitting Applications for 2024 Student Scholar Day

Student Scholar Day is an opportunity for students to professionally present scholarly work in their field.

Student Scholar Day: **April 11th 2024**
Deadline to Apply: **March 1st 2024**
Applicants notified: **March 17st 2024**

All presentations are in-person on **April 11th 2024**. Your scholarly work can be presented in the following formats:

Oral Presentation: 9-11 minutes of presentation followed by up to 3 minutes of Q&A

Performance: 9-11 minutes of performance followed by up to 3 minutes of Q&A

Lecture Recital: 9-11 minutes of recital followed by up to 3 minutes of Q&A

Poster Presentation: 2-3-minute overview to small panel followed by Q&A, plus available for approximately 45 minutes for public questions and viewing.

1. With the guidance of their mentor, **the applicant completes the application form by 11:59 p.m. on Friday, March 1st**. To access the application, go to: <https://forms.office.com/r/iNCyNdpelN>
2. The applicant must click: 'SAVE MY RESPONSE TO EDIT' at the end of the application.
3. The applicant will receive an email from Microsoft forms with their responses.
4. The applicant can make changes to the submission by accessing their editable form in their Microsoft office account under Forms. Please find 'forms' within your Microsoft office.

TITLE: Title of presentation (limit to 75 characters)

ABSTRACT: Abstract or brief description of the presentation. The abstract must be your original work describing the project/performance. It should explain the project's purpose and significance (the project's contribution to existing scholarship). If applicable, include information on research methods, pertinent or expected results and conclusions or recommendations.
(Limit to 1500 characters; the abstract and presentation title will be printed in the program.)
