EMANUEL CLEAVER II

Honorary Degree

Emanuel Cleaver, II is now serving his tenth term representing Missouri's Fifth Congressional District, the home district of President Harry Truman. He is a member of the House Committee on Financial Services; Ranking Member of the Subcommittee on Housing and Insurance; member of Subcommittee on Capital Markets; and member of the U.S. Helsinki Commission.

Having served for twelve years on the city council of Missouri's largest municipality, Kansas City, Cleaver was elected as the city's first African American Mayor in 1991.

During his eight-year stint in the Office of the Mayor, Cleaver distinguished himself as an economic development activist and an unapologetic redevelopment craftsman. He and the City Council brought a number of major corporations to the city, including TransAmerica, Harley Davidson, and Citi Corp. Cleaver also led the effort, after a forty-year delay, to build the South Midtown Roadway. Upon completion of this major thoroughfare, he proposed a new name: The Bruce R. Watkins Roadway. Additionally, his municipal stewardship includes the 18th and Vine Redevelopment, a new American Royal, the establishment of a Family Division of the Municipal Court, and the reconstruction and beautification of Brush Creek.

Cleaver has received five honorary Doctoral Degrees augmented by a bachelor's degree from Prairie View A&M, and a master's from St. Paul's School of Theology of Kansas City.

In 2009, Cleaver, with a multitude of accomplishments both locally and Congressionally, introduced the most ambitious project of his political career—the creation of a Green Impact Zone. This zone, consisting of 150 blocks of declining urban core, has received approximately \$125 million dollars in American Recovery and Reinvestment funds. The Green Impact Zone is aimed at making this high crime area the environmentally greenest piece of urban geography in the world. This project includes rebuilding Troost Avenue, rehabbing bridges, curbs and sidewalks, home weatherization, smart grid technology in

hundreds of homes, and most importantly, hundreds of badly needed jobs for Green Zone residents.

During the 112th Congress, Cleaver was unanimously elected the 20th chair of the Congressional Black Caucus.

In 2016, as Ranking Member of the Housing and Insurance Subcommittee, Cleaver successfully co-authored the largest sweeping reform bill on housing programs in 20 years, the Housing Opportunity Through Modernization Act, a bipartisan comprehensive housing bill that passed into law with a unanimous vote.

In 2018, Congressman Cleaver received the Harry S. Truman Good Neighbor Award, the highest honor bestowed by the Harry S. Truman Good Neighbor Award Foundation. Past honorees include President Bill Clinton, the late Senator John McCain, and Justice Sandra Day O'Connor.

Cleaver, a native of Texas, is married to the former Dianne Donaldson. They have made Kansas City home for themselves and their four children, and grandchildren.



JOHN R. “JAY” ASHCROFT *Commencement Speaker*

John R. “Jay” Ashcroft is Missouri’s 40th Secretary of State, elected in November 2016, and again in 2020. Each year Secretary Ashcroft makes it a priority to visit all 114 counties in the state to talk with and thank Missourians for their hard work and dedication.

Prior to being elected, Mr. Ashcroft worked as an engineer, professor and attorney. As secretary of state, he leads an office with more than 200 employees taking an active role in its administration.

Jay was born, raised and educated in Missouri. He and his wife, Katie, have three sons and one daughter.

Taylor's academic journey reflects a commitment to helping others. She completed her master's degree in psychology at Avila University, specializing in research. Prior to that, she completed her undergraduate training at Drake University, where she graduated Magna Cum Laude and received the Judith L. Allen Award for outstanding engagement in service

activities for the benefit of others. Taylor was also actively involved in the Stereotyping and Objectification Action Research Lab, where she conducted research projects on social belonging among women in STEM and relationships between women, money, and power. While at Avila, Taylor held roles as a graduate assistant for the School of Social Sciences and the Department of Psychology. She also joined Psi Chi, the psychology honors society. She participated in the Replication and Open Science Education Lab, contributing to research to bridge the replication crisis in psychological research. Taylor will soon begin a new role in Healthcare Recruiting in Portland, Oregon.

NAEEM MOORE, M.S. in Kinesiology Posthumous Degree

On the early morning of September 11, 2023, Avila University tragically lost a phenomenal soul. Naeem Moore commenced his college career at Avila University in 2016 attaining his bachelor's degree in Kinesiology in 2022. Naeem continued to pursue his master studies at Avila University in Kinesiology shortly after graduating undergrad.

Naeem Moore had a true affinity for football since the age of 5 years old when he was given the #9 jersey. He carried #9 with him into his high school where he dominated the field to say the least. Naeem was the top performing player on his team, receiving many accolades and recognition such as recurrent interviews from local news media for stats that were off the charts! Naeem was highly praised for his performance during his time at Cardinal Ritter College Prep High School. In 2015, out of thousands of footballers in the State of Missouri, Naeem received the Junior National Elite Award which is consider the Heisman Trophy Award amongst High School athletes. Unbeknownst to him, Naeem's performance left a legacy that would spark his high school to structure a highly recognized football program that has paved the way for current NFL draft picks today. Naeem continued on to Avila University's football program dominating the field in his #9 jersey.

While completing his Master's degree, Naeem dedicated his spare time to coaching a little league football team called the Dynasty in Kansas City, Missouri.

Naeem will forever be remembered by his loving spirit as he shared love to everyone without judgement. Naeem was the true definition of a giver, friend, and true teammate. His life was a blessing and the memories he created with those who knew him will truly be a treasure.

In remembrance of Naeem's life's legacy in 2024 his family will honor his life's purpose by launching "The Project 9 Foundation", an endowment that will disseminate resources to underserved communities that will give young kids a chance to thrive physically, mentally, socially through education and sports.
